ARTICLES XIII
Code Of Conduct And Disciplinary Actions And
Responsibilities For Players And/Or Parents

13.1 Disrespect:

Player - Any player who verbally abuses or physically abuses any coach, parent, or spectator at JYFA or CVFC functions will have their playing time for their next week's game forfeited and/or by two-thirds majority vote by Board of Directors can be permanently dismissed.

Parent - Any parent who verbally abuses or physically abuses any coach, player, or spectator at JYFA or CVFC function will not be tolerated, and by two-thirds majority vote by Board of Directors will result in their child's dismissal.

Excessive Absence : More than two absences will forfeit a player's playing time for that same week's game.

Responsibilities:

Player - Player must be responsible for all equipment at all times.

Parent - Parents are responsible for all transportation to and from practices and games.
